MEDIA NOTE: The health department and other community-based organizations that are part of the HIV/AIDS Network of Sarasota County (HANS) will offer free HIV testing as part of the local observance of National Gay Men's HIV/AIDS Awareness Day. A schedule of those events is at the end of this release.

National Gay Men's HIV/AIDS Awareness Day scheduled Sept. 27

HIV/AIDS Network of Sarasota County (HANS) joins with the National Association of People with AIDS (NAPWA) in launching the first annual National Gay Men's HIV/AIDS Awareness Day on Sept. 27. Free HIV testing will be offered to the public at numerous locations as part of this national observance.

National Gay Men's HIV/AIDS Awareness Day is a call to action that comes at time of heightened complacency, leading to a resurgence of new HIV infections among gay men.

"We are lucky to have such committed community organizations working on HIV prevention," said Stephen Warne, program coordinator. "These agencies are dedicated to reaching out to a population that has been largely underserved throughout the state."

- From 2001- 2006, men who have sex with men (MSM) across all racial and ethnic groups were the only transmission category with significant increases in HIV diagnoses.
- HIV incidence has been increasing steadily among gay and bisexual men since the early 1990s, consistent with increases in risk behavior, sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) and HIV diagnoses among MSM.
- Gay men comprise over half of the total number of total HIV/AIDS cases in the United States.
- More than 500,000 gay men of all colors have died in the United States.

HANS has been working diligently on addressing the needs of gay, bisexual and questioning/curious men who are at risk for HIV. Last year in response to the "OUT IN THE OPEN" report, HANS created a survey to gauge Sarasota's safe-sex behaviors and are continuing to engage the MSM community with events such as Gay Men's HIV awareness day, World AIDS day and ongoing monthly meetings where all are welcome.

David White from the HANS Speakers' Bureau noted that "there are men in every community affected by HIV/AIDS.

"Guesswork won't keep someone safe," he added. "It's important to protect yourself, get tested and take control of your own life."

HIV testing is fast and easy. People have a choice of getting the OraSure® HIV test or the Rapid Ora Quick. OraSure® testing consists of placing a treated cotton pad resembling a toothbrush between a person's cheek and gums for two minutes. It is easier than brushing your teeth. The Rapid Ora Quick HIV Test, a finger stick, provides preliminary results in only 20 minutes. Test results are always kept private and are not shared with anyone.

The Sarasota County Health Department offers additional recommendations to reduce risk for HIV infection:

- **Be safe:** The best way to prevent HIV is to abstain from having sex. If you do have sex, use a new condom every time. Do not share needles or syringes for any reason, whether to inject drugs (recreational or medical) or for tattoos and body piercing.

- **Talk about it:** Talk about sex and HIV with your partners. Find out when they were last tested for HIV and what their status was.
- **Talk to your doctors:** If you are sexually active, you should get tested for HIV at least once. Do not assume your doctor will ask you to be tested for HIV.
